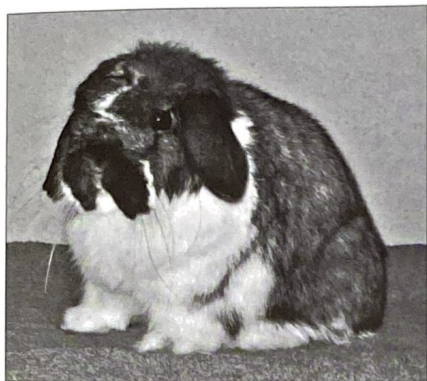
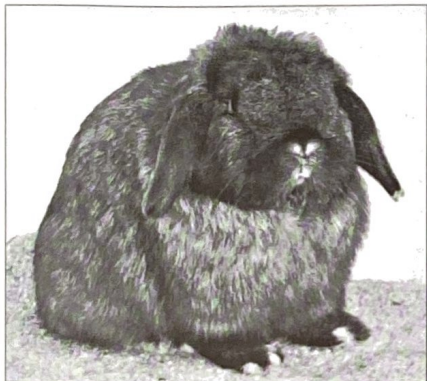

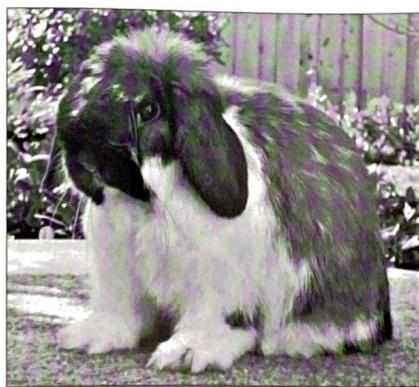
Brocks Fallen Ear's Orion - BJB

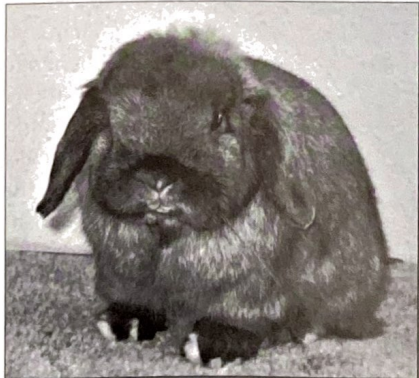

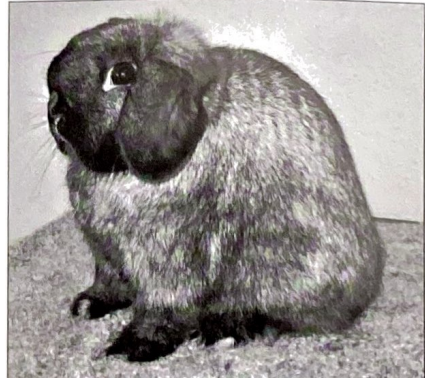

When we joined our rabbitries seven years ago, we were both feeling discouraged by the fierce competition in producing and showing quality Hollands.
